Shortening hems:	
* Sewn satin or lining layer	£35 per layer
* Tulle or netted layer	£15 per layer
* Lace or detailed outer hem, to original finish	£75 per layer
* Bagged out/ horsehair braided hem	£50 per layer
* Removing or shortening train	Approx £100
Taking in/ letting out side seams (Bust/ Waist/ Hips):	
* Plain satin or crepe dress, two layers, no boning	£50
* Plain satin or crepe dress with boning, multiple layers	£80
* Dress with lace details or beading, boned, multiple layers	£120
* Heavy/ full beading or lace appliqué dress	£150
Bustle & wrist loop for train	£30
Sewing in bra cups (We can provide ivory/ nude in various cup sizes)	£30
Taking up straps:	
* Thin straps, no detail	£30
* Wider straps with detailing to be re-sewn	£40
Adding covered buttons	£1 per button
Replacing original fastening with a corset back and modesty panel	£120
Adding or repairing beadwork/ sequins	From £30 per hour
Taking in sleeves	£40

The prices shown are a guideline, and a final, accurate quote will be sent out via email after we have pinned and evaluated your dress. You are not obligated to go ahead with the work at this point and we will ask for your approval before going ahead with any work. Once agreed, all alterations are done to the highest standards and will be sympathetic to the original design of the dress. If this is not possible, we will always inform you. You will then return two/ three weeks after the first fitting to check the alterations. In most instances, the dress is perfect and ready for your big day. Payment will be due if you are happy to collect at this point. Please note that occasionally there will be a need for further adjustments at this point.
